

Election Day is Tuesday, November 3, 2020

*New York - Early Voting Period is October 24, 2020 - November 1, 2020

YOUR VOTE IS NECESSARY!

7 Steps to Make SURE Your Vote Counts:

1. Make sure you are registered to vote TODAY: <https://www.vote.org/>
2. If you cannot get to the polls in person, request an absentee ballot. In most states, you can register to receive an absentee ballot by mail – request one ASAP!
 - a. NY - Print and mail: <https://www.elections.ny.gov/NYSBOE/download/voting/AbsenteeBallot-English.pdf>
 - b. NY - Request online: <https://www.vote.org/>
 - c. NY Call: 1-866-VOTE-NYC (1-866-868-3692)
3. Fill out your absentee ballot. Make sure to follow the instructions **exactly**.
 - a. Review ALL the candidates on your ballot, not just the candidates for President: <http://whosontheballot.org/>
4. Return your ballot ASAP by mail, at a designated drop box, or simply drop it off at your local election office. (<https://vote.nyc/page/contact-us>)
5. If early voting is an option, DO IT! (*It **IS** an option in NY!)
6. To vote in person - find your polling place, prepare for long lines, and wear a mask. <http://voting.nyc/>
7. Reach out to friends and family to help them vote! Share this information sheet with your network!
